Biographie

Nihiling, 4 boys and a girls in the beginning of their twenties, with a big head full of ideas of how to change music today. With a taste that reaches from the borders of electronic avant-garde over instrumental Post Rock to the progressive Metal sound of Scandinavia. From this mixture, Nihiling created kind of an own world on their 2009 debut record "M(e)iosis" that turned post and progressive fans all over Europe on the band.

By now Nihiling are one of the most active bands in their genre. Support shows and touring with acts as Long Distance Calling (D), Amplifier (UK), Mono (JP), Immanu El (SWE), This will destroy you (US), Caspian (US) or I Like Trains (UK) show the strong will of the Germans to show their fans in a live situation that they keep what they promise with their records. With a sound that sometimes reminds one of bands like Mogwai or Oceansize the band is able to reach fans outside of Germany. Even after the release of the first record "M(e)iosis" there were numerous reactions from all over the world. Thanks to Internet the five piece got a fan base in Asia as well as in South America.

In 2011 the band is about to release their second record "Egophagus" on the German label Abandon Records, featured by German publisher Playdead Music/BMG.

On "Egophagus" Nihiling take it from where "M(e)iosis" ends. As the world turns a little bit darker everyday, the music of the band follows. It's more intense, it's more atmospheric and at the same moment it is so focused on the songs. Progressive elements are always there, but they have to bend to the dictate of a story and a song. Few progressive bands can do that like Nihiling can, especially since it's only their second album.

If the band goes on like this and keep up the high number of live performance they can become one of the Top 10 in their genre.
